Can you make a clear statement about what is allowed to communicate? Of course before and during a QSO there should be NO communication whatsoever. But how should I understand: QSOs confirmed via Packet Radio or Internet do not count for the contest? Can I send a thank you to a station after a valid completed QSO? Can I tell him the number of bursts afterwards? Can I spot a CQing station (without the offset QRG)?

Dear Anton,

you can communicate after the contest, but not while you do the contest. Some OP's use the Internet in Chatrooms.

This year I had to control more than 600 lines with communications between MS Stations and for me it is not possible to control, if the communication takes place while the QSOs or after.

PA2CHR:

Nice contest again; increasing activity from the East I think. Sometimes good long burst's and sometimes nothing for 30 minutes or so.

One important thing: According to the rules it is not allowed 'to have QSO's confirmed via Packet or internet'.

About all operators are watching ON4KST-chat and the ones who are not in the contest very often just write:

"thanks for the QSO Chris and hope to cu again" or text like this. It is very impolite not having the possibility to write something back.....

because this can be seen as a confirmation of the QSO. Maybe it is possible to change this part of the rules to something like this:

"The use of DX-clusters and chat-channels during the contest is only allowed in such way that there is no exchange of reports or other data from which the status of the QSO can be extracted. Limited information on the cluster (e.g. 12:00 DK5EW PA4EME JN48MB<MS>JO20WX) or chat

(e.g. 12:00 PA2DW 144.355 CQ for MS Sprint) is allowed". This is the text of the rules for MS Sprint contest and I know a lot of people agree with this.

Maybe it is possible to think about this; there will be more participants in the contest for sure! Having Prefixes as a multiplier is very nice, pse keep it, hi. Anyway, I enjoyed the contest and will be there next year also.
